The project

Gemco is currently preparing the installation of two foundries in parallel in an existing facility in Egypt. At the beginning of 2024, installation works will begin to transform these existing buildings into factories with production lines with new machinery.

The internship

During your internship you become a member of the project team and you will assist the project manager, the site manager and engineers on site.

The site manager is responsible for the installation and commissioning, in coordination with the customer, of products and machinery on right time and in the right place under safe circumstances on the site. The installation of various machines will be performed by installation supervisors of the respective machines under the site manager's coordination and supervision of the overall installation works.

He takes care of a smooth organization, for the logistic processes and the safety of all employees. The site manager attends the site for a longer period of time. He is the linking pin between the customer, suppliers and his colleagues at Gemco in the Netherlands.



The project manager, who is overall responsible for the entire project, is working in the Netherlands and attends the site frequently.

The student will be located on-site and will support the site manager, engineers, the project manager and the other colleagues working on this specific project.

Depending on the skills and objectives of the student, the work may vary from organizing meetings with the customer and assisting in the supervision of suppliers to setting up and implementing logistic plans.

By being on-site, you will learn about what it takes to build a factory: the engineering and the different process equipment, planning, logistics, administration, control, safety, contact with customers, suppliers, locals, etcetera.

Your profile

You are studying mechanical or industrial engineering (bachelor) and would like to enlarge your theoretical knowledge with a practical (learning on the job) international internship.
