Project

Gemco is currently preparing the construction of two foundries in parallel in a partially existing facility in the above-mentioned country. By the end of 2023, these buildings must be constructed and transformed into running factories with production lines of new machinery.

The internship

During your internship you become a member of the project team and you will assist the project manager, the site manager, and engineers on site.

The site manager is responsible for the installation and commissioning, under supervision of suppliers and customer, of products and machineries on the right time and in the right place under safe circumstances on the site.

He takes care for a smooth organization, for the logistic processes and the safety of all employees. The site manager attends the site for a longer period of time. He is the linking pin between the customer, suppliers, and his colleagues of Gemco in the Netherlands.

The project manager is basically working in the Netherlands and attends the site frequently.

The student will be placed and work on site and will support the site manager, engineers, the project manager, and the other colleagues working for the specific project.



Depending on the skills and objective of the student, the work can vary from organizing meetings with customers, assisting in the supervision of suppliers to setting up and implement logistic plans.

Being on the site, you will learn about what it takes to build a factory: the engineering and the different process equipment, planning, logistics, administration, control, safety, and everything that may be needed in this phase of the project. You have contact with customers, suppliers, locals, and everyone who is part of the delivery, installation, and commissioning process.

You are studying mechanical engineering (bachelor) and you would like to enhance your theoretical knowledge with a practical (learning on the job) international internship.

You can cope with stress, you brim with energy, you can work in a team, you are client oriented, and you are willing to travel and stay for a longer period of time abroad.
